**From I 90**

Exit onto Highway 75, which only goes west. This a Beloit exit. Keep going west until street ends in T intersection with Blackhawk, turn right and go north one block. There will be a McDonalds on the right at the intersection where you turn left onto Shirland Ave, go west on Shirland until it ends by turning to the right and going north [it becomes Frederick after the turn.] Go north on Frederick approx half mile. Where it ends in T intersection, turn left and go west on St. Lawrence, which becomes a country road, go on it 5 or so miles, cross a stream, and then turn left and go south on Burchfield. Farm is on the right with a large sign: Brown Deer Farm.

*Burchfield is easy to miss as it is a small T intersection. If you come to H or K you have gone too far.*

**From Rockford**

Go North on Highway 2, turn left on Rockton Rd at stop light, just after crossing the river, and go west into Rockton.

OR

Go North on Highway 251, pass through the large intersection at Hononegah Road in Roscoe, and take the off ramp for Rockton Rd. Turn right and go west on Rockton Road into Rockton.

Go west through the town, past the village park and Old Stone Church. When you in the country west of Rockton, you will go over river twice, then turn right on Prairie Rd and go north.

[After you cross the river the second time, you will see Bluff Rd, the next road is Prairie.] On Prairie Rd, you will come to a 4 way stop. Turn left and go west on Yale Bridge Rd. You will pass the Christmas tree farm. Go about 4 miles on Yale Bridge Rd from the intersection with Prairie.

When you come to large electrical towers, you are getting close. After a slight downhill slope in the road, turn right on Sharp Rd. [If you come to Boswell, you have gone way too far.] Go north on Sharp Rd about a mile. This road has a right angle turn to the right and then to the left, making a jog in the road. After these two turns, the road is called Burchfield. Farm is on the left with large sign: Brown Deer Farm.

***What to Bring:***

*Sleeping bag and pillow, towel and personal care items [soap, shampoo, tooth brushing], jacket, walking shoes, comfortable casual clothing, insect repellent and sunscreen*

*Writing materials*
